Public Consultation on Draft National Policy on Natural Gas

The Ministry of Highways & Road Development and Petroleum Resources Development has prepared a draft national policy on natural gas with a view to:

- facilitate the exploration and production of natural gas, importation and exportation of Liquefied Natural Gas and utilization of natural gas as an energy source and raw material; and
- establish the legal, regulatory and institutional framework for the natural gas industry in Sri Lanka.
